COMMENTS

Plantation districts have mostly enjoyed bright and sunny weather throughout the week but the Department of Meteorology predicts some thundershowers in Nuwara Eliya and scattered showers in the Western region in the week ahead. A slight decline in crop has been reported from the Western estates as well as Low Grown plantations, whilst harvests elsewhere have largely remained unchanged.

This week's auction (Sale # 42) was conducted on October 27 & 28 (Tue/Wed) and the quantity 5.1 m/kgs was 0.3 m/kgs lower than the previous sale. The Low Grown Leafy/ Semi Leafy/ Tippy & Small Leaf/ Premium Flowery catalogues totaled 2.4 m/kgs, whilst Main Sale High & Medium category amounted to 0.6 m/kgs. The Ex Estate catalogue had 0.6 m/kgs.

Ex Estate teas met with fair general demand. Selected western BOP's were up to Rs. 20/- dearer whilst their corresponding BOPF's were mostly lower by Rs. 10/- to 20/-. Below best and plainer category BOP's from the western slopes were firm, whilst their BOPF counterparts were irregular and easier. Nuwara Eliya's continued to sell at attractive levels. Uda Pussellawa BOP's were irregular but, their neater BOPF ruled firm to dearer. Some select Uva BOP's were substantially dearer; others together with BOPF's gained Rs. 10/- per kg. CTC PF1's were Rs. 10/- to 20/- dearer. There was strong demand from China and the "Tea Bag" sector operating for Russia continued to be active. Japan and Europe bid on the better liquoring teas. Hong Kong was active for below-best high grown.

Low grown leafy teas again met with fair demand. The best available OP1's were firm while below best teas were irregular. Select OP's were maintained while others were irregular and easier. Clean and true-to-type OPA's were fully firm to dearer. In the semi-leafy segment, BOP1's were in general of a lower market. Stylish Pek/Pek 1's were firm whilst prices were seen to pick up for lower-end sorts. In the Tippy Catalogue, FBOP's/ FBOPF1's in the "best" category were firm whilst bottom level teas ruled firm to dearer. There was limited interest from Germany for the better BOP1's whilst Saudi Arabia lent good support for most leafy teas. Other Middle Eastern buyers together the C.I.S and Turkey were active. Libya operated at the bottom end. Russia continued to make their purchases for their winter season.

This week's auction comprised of **9,694** lots with a total quantity of **5,128,728** kgs.

- BOP1** : Select best teas declined Rs.40-50/- per kg; balance too lower by Rs.20-30/- per kg. Teas in the lower category were barely steady.
- OP1** : Teas in the select best category were barely steady; balance declined Rs.3-40/- per kg and at times more. Stalky invoices too declined and at times were difficult of sale.
- OP** : Best teas were lower by Rs.20/- per kg and at times more; balance declined Rs.10-20/- per kg. Teas at the lower end were generally firm.
- OPA** : Select best invoices were maintained; balance was fully firm on last week levels. Poor sorts declined Rs.20/- per kg.
- PEK/PEK1**: Well-made PEK's were lower by Rs.30-40/- per kg; balance maintained last week levels. Best bold PEK's were barely steady; balance declined by Rs.20-30/- per kg and at times more. Teas at the lower end tended irregular.

- BOPF/BOPFSP** : In general firm.
- FBOP/FBOP1** : Select best and best FBOP's firm. Cleaner below best and bolder varietites together with cleaner teas at the lower end appreciated. Others were firm. FBOP1's in general firm to dearer.
- FBOPF/FBOPF1**: Leafy-Tippy varieties with the well-made smaller tips appreciated. Best maintained. Below best and lower end teas were irregular following quality. Select best FF1's firm. Well-made neater varieites together with cleaner below best were firm to selectively dearer. Others were irregular. Cleaner teas at the lower end too were firm to dearer. Balance sold around last level.
- FBOPFSP/EXSP** : Except for few Invoices in the top category which sold well others declined and below best varieties firm to lower as the sale progressed. Teas at the lower end sold at last week levels.

Crop & Weather

For the period 19th-25th October, 2020

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions - Bright weather was reported from the Western Region. The Nuwara Eliya Region reported bright weather at the beginning of the week and dull weather towards the end of the week. The Department of Meteorology predicts occasional showers in the Western Region and thundershowers in the Nuwara Eliya Region in the week ahead. **Uva/Udapussellawa Regions** - Both regions reported bright weather. Heavy showers are expected in the Uva Region in the week ahead according to the Department of Meteorology. **Low Grown** - Bright weather was reported in the Low Grown Region. Occasional showers are forecast by the Department of Meteorology in the week ahead.

Crop Intake - The Western and Low Grown regions experienced a slight decrease in the crop intake, whilst the Nuwara Eliya, Uva and Uda pusellawa regions maintained.

BANGLADESH AUCTION**Sale 22 held on Monday, 27th October, 2020**

CTC LEAF: 49,284 packages of Current Season and 50 packages of Old Season teas on offer once again met with a fairly good demand but generally eased a little.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring BOPs were in fairly good demand and eased by upto Tk.3/-. Their GBOPs met with a good market and were mostly firm to slightly easier by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/-. Medium varieties continued to follow a similar trend. Plain and BLF teas witnessed a little more interest but prices were much lower. There were again quite a lot of withdrawals in this category.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings met with a good demand but mostly eased by upto Tk.3/-. Medium types also met with a good demand and eased by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/-. Plain and BLF teas were again a weak market and withdrawals were quite heavy.

CTC DUST: 10,690 packages of Current Season and 18 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a good demand. Well made good liquoring Dusts were fully firm to slightly dearer closely following quality. Others were easier by Tk.5/- and often more with a few withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts were difficult of sale. Blenders were more active on brighter liquoring Dusts whilst Loose tea buyers showed fair interest on other varieties.
