

# LANKA COMMODITY BROKERS LTD TEA MARKET REPORT

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# SALE NO.13 OF 30<sup>TH</sup> /31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2021

# <u>COMMENTS</u>

This week's tea auction (Sale # 13) was conducted on March 30 & 31 (Tue/Wed) and, the offer quantity of 6.5 m/kgs was 0.3 m/kgs higher than the previous week. The Low Grown Leafy/ Semi Leafy/ Tippy & Small Leaf/ Premium Flowery catalogues totaled 3 m/kgs, up 0.17 m/kgs from the previous sale, whilst Main Sale High & Medium category amounted to 0.8 m/kgs. The Ex Estate catalogue had 1 m/kgs.

The Ex Estate market was once again lower with less demand from most liquoring buyers. Western quality showed a further drop this week, and only a limited selection of seasonal BOP's that attracted Air-Mail interest received firm prices whilst others together with BOPF's in the "best" category eased Rs. 30/- to 50/-. The better Nuwara Eliya's sold well although at slightly reduced rates, whilst Uva/Uda Pussellawa BOP's declined Rs. 20/- to 30/- and BOPF's eased Rs. 30/- to 40/-. CTC teas also saw much less demand particularly towards the close of the sale where a large number of invoices remained unsold. There was only fair interest from the UK, Japan and Germany for best Westerns. Buyers for China and Hong Kong operated at lower levels. Russia showed subdued interest for "Tea Bag" types concentrating more on the neater leaf teas.

There was only fair demand at lower levels for Low Growns following selective demand by Turkey, the largest buyer of Ceylon Teas so far this year. A new monetary crisis in Turkey has caused its lira to fall dramatically on Monday morning, and the response from the financial community was swift and overwhelmingly negative with a fear that inflation was likely to accelerate. The Middle Eastern buyers and those operating for the C.I.S continued to purchase their usual requirements at lower price levels ahead of the Ramadan Season. The better leafy OP1's were about firm whilst others were all easier. The best OP/OPA's maintained but others were lower. Stylish BOP1's held firm. A range of select best PEK/PEK1's were firm; most others tended irregular and easier. The best FBOP's and FBOPF1's were selectively dearer whilst the balance was mostly lower.

This week's auction comprised of **11,606** lots with a total quantity of **6,561,411** kgs.

#### LOW GROWNS - LEAFY

- **BOP1** : Select best invoices were irregular; balance was generally lower. Teas at the lower end too declined by Rs.20/-.
- **OP1** : Teas in the select best category were maintained; balance declined by Rs.30/- per kg. Stalky invoices held firm.
- **OP** : Select best teas were lower by Rs.20/- per kg; balance was irregular Teas at the lower end were maintained.
- **OPA** : Select best invoices declined by Rs.20-30/- per kg; balance were barely steady. Poorer sorts generally firm.
- **PEK/PEK1:** Well made stalky invoices declined Rs.20-30/- and more as the sale progressed; balance was irregular. Best bold Pekoes fully firm ; balance tended irregular, Teas at the lower end were generally lower.

- **BOP/BOPSP** : Select Best and Best BOPs were easier. Cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the lower end were firm on last. Balance were easier following quality.
- **BOPF/BOPFSP** : BOPF in general firm.
- **FBOP/FBOP1** : Select Best FBOPs firm to selectively dearer whilst Best sold around last levels. Below Best together with bolder varieties declined. However, teas at the lower end were firm on last. FBOP1's in general firm.
- **FBOPF/FBOPF1 :** Very Tippy teas continue to attract good demand. Best and Below Best were firm. Teas at the lower end were irregular following quality. However, the leafier varieties were irregularly easier. Few select Best FF1s maintained. Balance together with Best declined. Cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the lower end were firm. Balance were easier following quality.
- **FBOPFSP/EXSP :** Invoices in the top category and the below best held firm. Teas at the lower end sold at last week levels.

**BOP:** Best Western's a few select seasonal invoices were firm and dearer following special inquiry, whilst the others were irregularly easier. Teas in the Below Best category declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more, whilst the Plainer sorts were firm. Nuwara Eliaya's continued to sell well at firm to dearer rates. Uda Pussellawa's were irregular and barely steady. Uva's – Few select invoices appreciated following special inquiry, whilst the others declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more.

**BOPF:** Best Western's – declined Rs. 30-50 per kg and more for select high priced teas of last week. Teas in the Below Best category declined Rs. 20-30 per kg, whilst the Plainer sorts were Rs. 10-20 per kg lower. Nuwara Eliya's continued to sell well. Uda Pussellawa's were firm around last week's levels. Uva's – Better sorts were Rs. 30-40 per kg easier, whilst the others were Rs. 10-20 per kg lower.

# Crop & Weather

### For the period 22/03/2021 to 28/03/2021

**Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions** - The Western and Nuwara Eliya regions experienced sunny mornings and scattered evening showers, whilst a few sub-districts in the Bogawantalawa Region reported heavy rainfall during the evening hours. The Department of Meteorology expects misty conditions and heavy rain during the evening hours in both regions in the week ahead. **Uva/Udapussellawa\_Regions** - The Udapussellawa Region reported bright mornings and evening showers, whilst the Kandapola Region reported rainfall towards the latter part of the week. Clear mornings and occasional evening showers were reported in the Uva Region throughout the week. Heavy showers are expected in the Uva Region in the week ahead according to the Department of Meteorology.

**Low Growns** - Sunny mornings and occasional evening showers were reported in the Low Grown Region throughout the week. Heavy showers are expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions by the Department of Meteorology in the week ahead

**Crop Intake** -\_The Western, Uva, Udapussellawa and a few sub-districts in the Kandapola Region reported an increase in the crop intake, whilst the Nuwara Eliya and Low Grown regions maintained.
