



Sri Lanka has recorded a disappointing tea production of only 20 Mkgs for November 2021, which is a decline of almost 5 Mkgs when compared to the corresponding month in 2020. The drop in harvest from High & Medium elevations amounted to 1.3 Mkgs and 0.9 Mkgs respectively, whilst the Low Grown crop declined by 2.6 Mkgs. During the year-to-date period of 2021, the total crop of 278.7 Mkgs shows a gain of 28.5 Mkgs over January, November 2020, but this cannot be considered any achievement, due to 2020 being one of the worst years for national production. The lack of fertilizer this year had a huge impact on production, and, the worst affected is the smallholder sector which controls the majority of the planted hectarage. Tea Industry experts believe that the non-application of fertilizer would have a continuing negative effect on the overall production during the next several months.
