


LANKA COMMODITY BROKERS LTD SRI LANKA TEA PRODUCTION-JUNE, 2024



Sri Lanka has produced 23.02 MKGS of tea in June, 2024 which reflects a slight decline when compared with June, 2023 by 0.64 MKGS. During the month under review, High Growns have recorded a loss whilst Medium and Low Growns have recorded gains over the corresponding month of the previous year, as shown from the undernoted statistics. During the first half of this year (Jan/June), the National Tea Production decreased to 127.43 Mkgs from 134.7 Mkgs recorded in the corresponding period last year which shows a sharp decrease of approx. 7.2 Mkgs.
