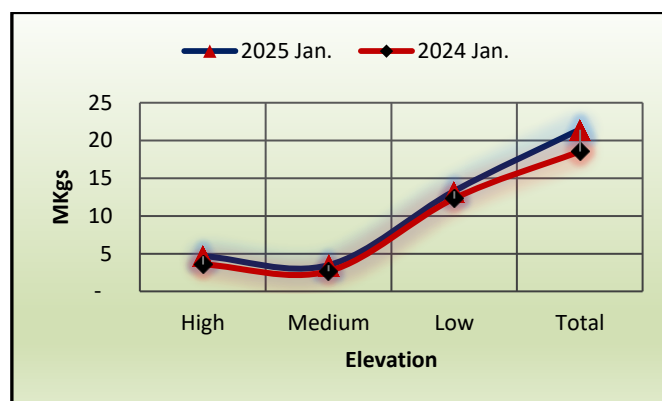


Sri Lanka has achieved a production figure of 21.5 Mkgs during January 2025, which shows an increase of 2.9 Mkgs when compared to January 2024. The elevation wise breakdown of production is given below for your information. The latest weather reported from most Planting Districts have experienced bright weather with hardly any rain being reported during the last few days which is conducive for Quality Manufacture, and this weather pattern is predicted to continue throughout the month which could have a bearing on the month's production.
